➤ **Dog Training**

All training programs are customized and modified according to the needs of individual pets and clients. Dogs retain private lesson work better than group training, and even after one session, you see results of the new desired behavior. With any one of the training programs (outlined below) and daily practice, you will learn proper communication with your dog to form a habit of good behavior and teamwork! Weekly homework packets are included with each program to give you step-by-step guidance in between sessions.

✿ **Puppy Manners and Training**

This puppy introduction is designed to start you and your pet out on the right paw. You will learn how to prevent and treat unwanted behaviors, build a strong relationship with your pet as a pack leader, start a positive and motivational line of communication with your pet, and use substitute behaviors to replace unwanted ones.

This course includes the following:

- Obedience command introduction for sit, down, wait, place, and proper leash walking.
- Hand signals and verbal commands
- Potty training, crate training, and behavior modification

A Dog's Perspective:

Canine pack relationships are based on the hierarchy of the pack with one leader, or alpha, who dominates, establishes organization, disciplines, and maintains group order. In the absence of a leader at home, a dog will take the alpha role in a family.

🐾 **Obedience Program:**

We begin with your pet's evaluation and the initial consultation, a history and overview of your pet's routine behaviors and the owner's responses to those behaviors, in order to form a personalized training session for each individual pet and owner's needs with result oriented training. The cost of this program includes weekly lessons in your home until training is complete for the following list of commands.

- This course is for basic control on leash.
 - At the end of training, your dog will do the following on leash:
 - **SIT** on one command
 - **DOWN** on one command
 - **COME** when called
 - **STAY** (in a sit or down position) until released
 - **HEEL** at your left side, with an automatic sit when you halt.
 - **GO** – walk away from front door, dinner table, or any area
- We start a positive and motivational line of communication with your pet that results in respect and not demands from your pet.
- Hand signals and verbal commands are used to direct your pet.
- Basic behavior modification for jumping, barking, talking back, digging, biting, accidents, and more.

Friendly Tip:

Since every private session is personalized for your pet, you'll need a notepad and pen handy for instructions that pertain to your specific needs.

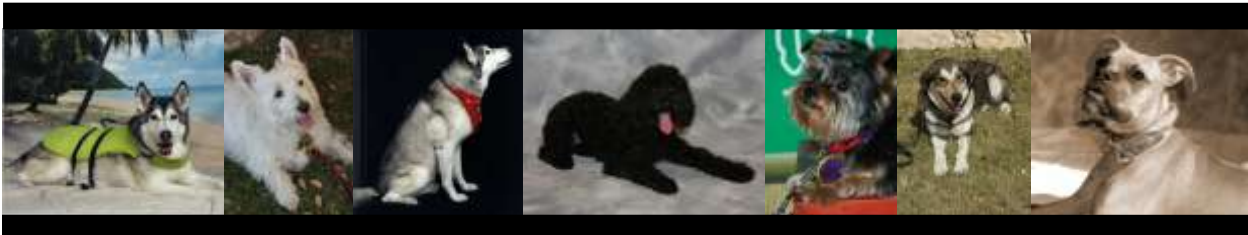
🐾 **Behavior Modification:**

Treatment training for intermediate to severe cases of behaviors that can range from separation anxiety, destructive behavior, prey drive, and the following types of aggression: territorial, dominance, and fear. Pack leadership drills, obedience commands, desensitization, and counter conditioning are all part of forming a new routine of good behavior in your daily lives.

🐾 **In-Board Training:**

In-board training can be added to any program to complete your pet's obedience training in less time or may be used with challenging behavior modifications that require extensive daily training. The trainer personally works with your pet daily and finishes your pet's training for you.

For owners who want the benefits of the end result of training without the multiple weeks of daily practice to progress with the pet or no longer have the time to dedicate to daily training. The time it would take for you to train your dog daily at home with weekly private lessons would be reduced by fifty percent with this service.
